The jury panel will evaluate the proposals and select the final nominees (i.e. the 3 best proposals per category) on the basis of the selection criteria.

Each jury members will give a mark from 0 (minimum) to 5 (maximum) for each of the question; the calculation of the average mark will give the ranking.

Jury will deal with eventual ex-aequos during its meeting.

The decisions taken by the jury will be final.

Ambition (25%)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is the level of innovation (incremental or radical/disruptive)? • What problem/challenge is the innovation addressing? • What is the gap that the innovation is bridging? • What is the potential of this innovation in the future?
Market relevance (25%)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Which benefits for the OEM and/or end consumer is the innovation addressing? • What added value is created to the end consumer? • How well has cost-effectiveness been addressed? • Is the innovation enabling more than one application/solution?
Impact (25%)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How relevant is the innovation in the chosen category? • Are there immediate impacts or long-term effects? • Is the innovation enabling additional innovations? • What are the short and long-term realized business success factors?
Quality (25%)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How sound is the overall concept, technology or system? • Is the innovation already implemented and if not which TRL is reached? • What are the risk factors for success? • Have risk factors been considered?
