The European automotive industry is undergoing an unprecedented **green & digital transformation**. The mobility ecosystem is facing additional pressures caused by continued supply chain disruptions post COVID-19, and increases in the price of raw materials, energy and semiconductors.

The transition impacts on the **15 million people** employed in the automotive value-chain, putting jobs at risk combined with **challenges** in acquiring new skilled talent for emerging jobs.

It is in this context that the Automotive Skills Alliance was created in November 2020 under the **Pact for Skills**, the first flagship action of the **European Skills Agenda**, firmly anchored in the principles of the European Pillar of Social Rights. The pact aims to mobilise and incentivise private and public stakeholders to invest and take concrete action for the upskilling and reskilling of people of working age.



The Automotive Skills Alliance brings together different stakeholders involved in the automotive ecosystem and to **ensure continuous, pragmatic and sustainable cooperation** on the skills agenda in the ecosystem, collaborating at **European**, as well as on **national** and **regional** level.
